This past season, the FOTG welcomed Kevin Watson as Manager of Business Operations. Watson, who has a long-standing history with the team dating back to his days as the "radio guy" in the early 1990s, has played a key role in increasing community engagement, fostering relationships with fans, sponsors, and alumni, and raising awareness about the team.

For the Grizzlys to continue thriving in Olds, the new ownership will need sustained support through sponsorships, volunteer efforts, and enthusiastic fan attendance at games.
